

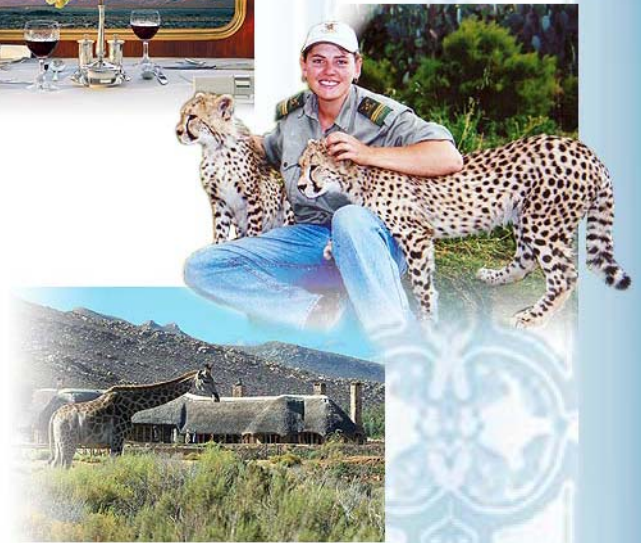


# Itinerary

## Cape Town to Pretoria Route

### Day 1: Applicable for 2008

- 07:50 - 08:30** Register and check-in at The Blue Train Lounge, **Cape Town Station**.
